Who can visit?

- We are always happy to welcome school groups of up to 50 students from Year 10, 11 and 12. There is no charge for the visit. Please note that we do not organise individual student visits.
- We prioritise UK schools from disadvantaged areas and students from underrepresented backgrounds and we are happy to host visits for other schools if we have the capacity.

When is the best time to visit?
